**Commentary on areas for action:**

**‘I know how well I am doing at school’**

This has increased to 83%, but our ambition is to reach over 90% of our pupils feeling confident that they know how well they are doing at school. Mrs Mitchell and the School Council will investigate what the pupils want to know and share this with the teachers.

**‘Most children behave well at school’**

This has also increased to 83%. The school focus on Behaviour4Learning has improved pupil perception, but it will remain a continued drive, so that we have over 90% of pupils reporting that most children behave well.

**“The playground is a fun and safe place”**

This has increased to 89%, and so to take our pupil views to above 90%, Mrs Mitchell will work with School Council to continue to address this area of our pupil’s lives. The School Council will investigate the areas of the playground and school that pupils feel less safe in, and introduce pupil-led solutions.

**“The School Council helps make decisions to improve the school”**

Whilst this has also improved to 83% from 75%, Mrs Mitchell will work with the group to raise its profile and impact. Meetings are to be held fortnightly from September 17, and the decisions made will be shared via the display board and Newsletters.

**“My school has lots of clubs I can go to”**

This was a new question for 2017, and results show that we do need to improve on this for our pupils. Mrs Mitchell will work with School Council to carry out a clubs audit and then work with them to recruit a wider range of clubs to respond to the interests of the pupils.
