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Message from the Head Teacher

Dear Parents and Carers

I just wanted to send a heartfelt thank you from all of the staff here at St Andrew's for all your kind words and wishes you have passed on to us about Mrs Coward's death.

We spoke to the children on Wednesday, and even though the news was difficult and emotional to hear, the children did very well. So many pupils had memories and stories about her, and this will be something I pass onto Mrs Coward's husband and 2 children. I think they will find great comfort in hearing how beloved she was to so many of our children.

We are checking our classroom worry boxes daily to monitor pupils, but if you feel your child needs any extra pastoral support, please do not hesitate to reach out. The pastoral team are always here ready to comfort, listen and support in any way we can. This offer also extends to you as parents, as we are aware cancer and loss has touched so many of our lives and this may be triggering for yourselves as well.

I made an error earlier in the week and thought the funeral service was later in the afternoon. I have received confirmation it is at an earlier time so the school will be closing slightly earlier at 1.00pm. Sincere apologies for my mistake.

Early School Closure Monday 13th May – 1.00pm pick up

- Lunchtime will run slightly earlier on the day but every child will eat their school dinner or packed lunch as normal
- Pick up is at 1.00pm from the usual classroom doors
- Pupils will have a paper pack of learning in their book bags (this optional learning, not compulsory)

never had a bad word to say about anyone.
