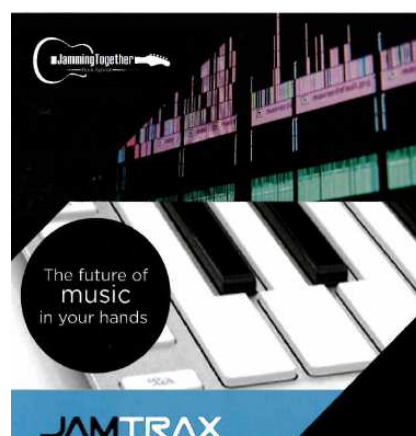


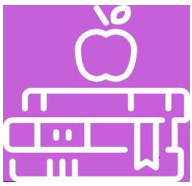
St Andrew's school offers a music technology club for children in Year 3-6 called 'JamTrax'.

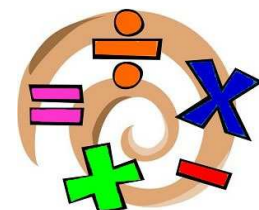
