Our imaginative learning project for next half term is: Who lives in a rockpool?

Our linked topic book will be: The Snail and the Whale by Julia Donaldson

The memorable experience for this project will be: Beach Day!

In this project we will be looking at the seaside and some of its geographical features. We will also be comparing how the seaside is different now to 100 years ago. We will be learning about the animals that live in the sea and how litter and pollution can affect them.

When the weather looks good we will have a beach day! We will convert our sandpit area into a beach for the day (complete with ice cream and paddling pools). On this day we will ask that you send child to school in beach clothes with a sun hat. If you have one, your child will also be able to bring a named bucket and spade or a small inflatable if they would like.
